



## Gilpin County Fair

### Code of Conduct for Political Organizations

All political organizations, candidates and their representatives/supporters will:

- Promote their cause ONLY in their designated booth space.
- Not campaign or draw attention to their candidacy or cause outside of their designated booth space. (Simply wearing a T-shirts outside of the booth space is allowed, but you must not draw attention to it.)
- Refrain from displaying any demeaning, harassing, aggressive, or intimidating materials or behavior.
- Be mindful of others around you to ensure a great experience for all Fair goers.
- Promptly report any behavior that makes you or others feel uncomfortable to the nearest Gilpin County Fair representative.
- Share this Code of Conduct with other political candidates, representatives and supporters in their party.

#### Consequences of inappropriate behavior

- Behavior in violation of this policy will not be tolerated. If asked to stop behaving inappropriately by the Gilpin County Fair management, you should comply immediately.
- Gilpin County Fair management reserves the right to refuse entry to or remove any group or individual from the event at any time. All determinations are at the sole discretion of Gilpin County Fair management, and the decision of the Gilpin County Fair Coordinator will be final.
- Severe breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disqualification from participating in future events.
- Individuals expelled due to violating this Code of Conduct will not be eligible for a refund or other consideration.
